BRIEF SYLLABUS 38:578:525 Public Sector Employment Issues

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Scope and nature of public employment; organizations of public employees; problems and issues of federal, state, county, and municipal employees; special problems of particular groups; emerging patterns and future developments.
