

Joe Bozich and Scott Nova will discuss the Alta Gracia line of collegiate apparel and Rachel Weeks will discuss the School House line of collegiate apparel.

Alta Gracia is a Knights Apparel initiative in which workers in a factory in the Dominican Republic are paid a living wage, are represented by a democratic union, and whose working conditions are humane and in compliance with university codes of conduct. The WRC publicly monitors and verifies working conditions at the factory.

School House is a line of collegiate apparel, that is sourced from a factory in Sri Lanka that pays a living wage to its workers.



On November 8, the panel members will also participate in a seminar hosted by the Division of Global Affairs on the Newark Campus, 12:00 – 2:00 pm, Engelhard Hall, room 209. The seminar is taught by Professor Kevin Kolben. All interested parties are welcome.
