### VIRTUAL INFORMATION LITERACY SESSIONS

Information literacy sessions are available remotely. Sessions can be accommodated either synchronously or asynchronously. Live presentations can be incorporated into the course, or pre-recorded videos can be created for your students to watch. Topics that can be covered include proper citation methods, avoiding plagiarism, identifying credible and/or scholarly sources, search strategies, and overviews of the resources available.

Invite me into your course in order to communicate directly with your students if they have any questions about the resources available to them.
